

IN RECOGNITION OF FAMILY CAREGIVERS MONTH

November is National Family Caregivers Month, which raises awareness of caregiving issues, educates communities, increases support for caregivers, empowers caregivers to prioritize their needs, and raises awareness about resources and services for caregivers' health and well-being.

"They're cheerleaders and crisis managers, nurses and advocates, therapists and service coordinators. They're not just family members—they're lifelines. Family caregivers are the backbone of care for people with intellectual and developmental disabilities (IDD), and their stories often go untold."

The Arc's 2023 Family and Individual Needs for Disability Supports (FINDS) survey highlights the need for better support systems for caregivers and their loved ones. Their insights challenge how our society views disability, family, and community:

- Over 50% report very high or extreme stress levels
- 90% have seen their careers impacted
- More than 4 in 5 have had to provide increased support
